The Lurie Cancer Center's NCI-funded Training Program in Signal Transduction and Cancer (T32 CA070085, PI: Platanius) will have one postdoctoral position available as of September 1, 2018. Postdoctoral appointments are for one year with the opportunity to renew for a second year. The fellowship includes benefits, travel allowance and annual supplies in addition to the stipend. Salary is commensurate with years of postdoctoral training.
